

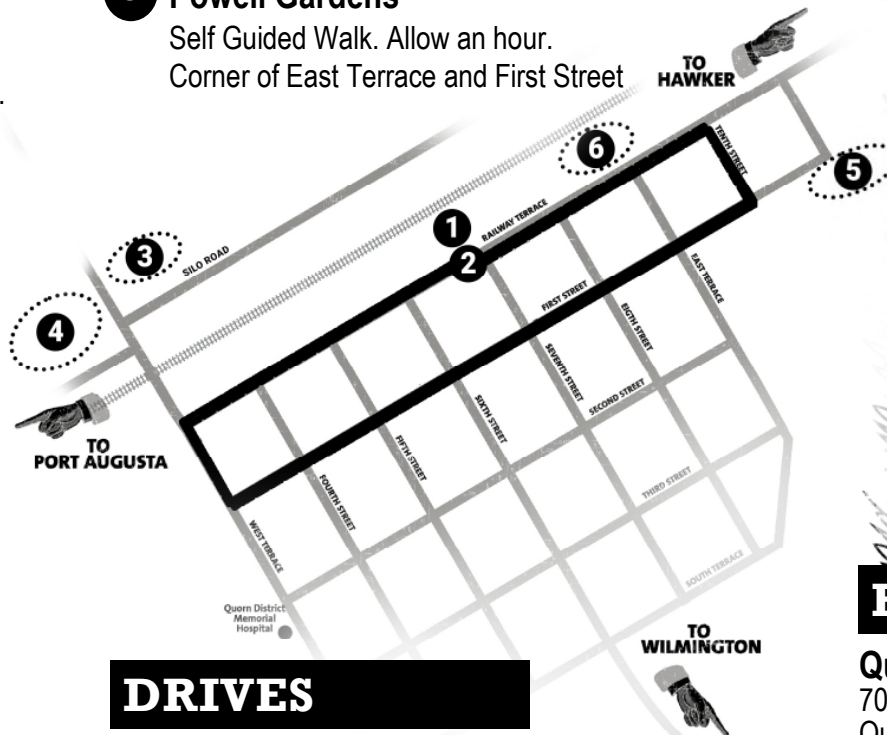

DRIVES

- Buckaringa Scenic Drive**
35km from Quorn, past Buckaringa Sanctuary and Proby's Grave, taking you to the Buckaringa Lookout car park. 100 m walk to the lookout for panoramic views.
- Proby's Grave Site**
Historic marker with story. 30km from Quorn
- Kanyaka and Death Rock**
Station Ruins, Waterhole, Cultural Sites. 42km from Quorn on the way to Hawker
- Yarrah Vale Gorge Road**
Spectacular views heading east from Arden Vale Road to Flinders Ranges Way.

- 3 Quorn Silo Light Show**
Every night of the year see spectacular animated show about the region, followed by exhibition.

BUSH WALKS

- Quorn Native Flora Reserve**
700m circuit, Easy walk
Quarry Road just outside of Quorn
- Warren Gorge Trail**
5.2km circuit, 1.5-3km hours, Undulating Terrain
Moderately Easy. Home of Yellow Footed Rock Wallaby
- Devils Peak Walking Trail**
2.4 km return walk, 1.5 to 3 hours return
Moderate Difficulty. Steep Terrain, Great Views
- Mt Brown Conservation Park**
14.9 km circuit, 6 hour return walk
Moderate difficulty, mixed terrain, Great Views
- Dutchman Stern Hike**
Two bushwalk options, 4 hour return walk to summit, or 5 hr circuit walk. Moderate difficulty, Great views.

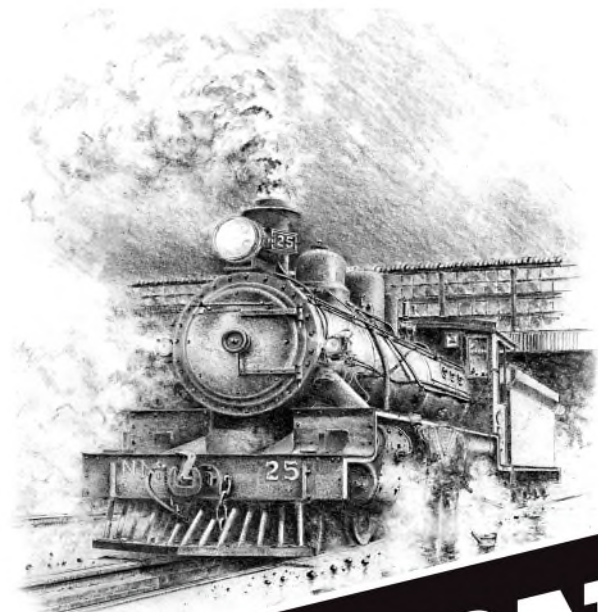
