#### **DOG REGISTATION 2018-2019**

As of 1 July 2018, South Australia's dogs and cats registrations will be undertaken by the Dog and Cat Management Board via the Dog and Cat Online System (DACO).

DACO will send the 2018-2019 renewal letter by post. Registration and payments will be undertaken online. Council will still be available to assist with online registration if access to the internet is not available or problems are encountered.

Once registration and payment is complete, a registration disk will be sent by post. The disk number will now remain the animals number for life.

If you have a 2017-2018 registered animal that, has moved out of the district, changed owners or passed away please notify Council as soon as possible.

<u>Please note:</u> that any dog over the age of 3 months <u>MUST</u> be registered and all dogs staying within our Council for longer than 14 days must also be registered within our Council.

#### **REMINDER:**

Before 1 July 2018 all dogs need to be microchipped and all dogs born after the 1 July 2018 need to be Microchipped and Desexed (exemptions apply for certain classes of dogs).

All cats need to be desexed and microchipped to be able to be registered.

#### **SOLAR LIGHTS - QUORN AND HAWKER**

Council is aware that some solar lights are currently not working.

Rechargeable batteries are an important component of our solar lights as they store the power generated by the energy from the sun.

Most of the rechargeable batteries in our solar lights have gone past their economic life. We are now looking at economic replacement options of the rechargeable batteries and are hoping to bring all the lights back into service by mid May 2018.
