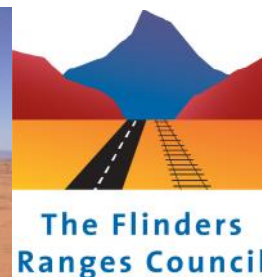

FAREWELL Bilal

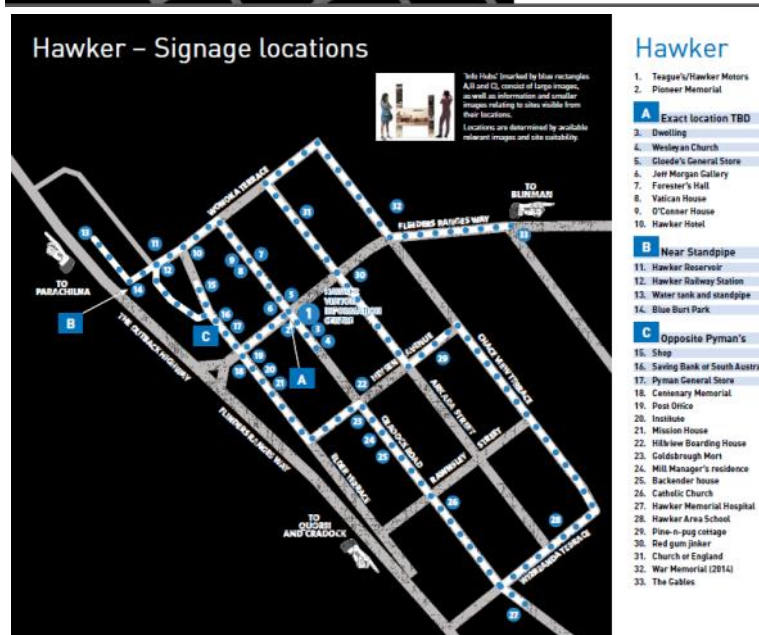
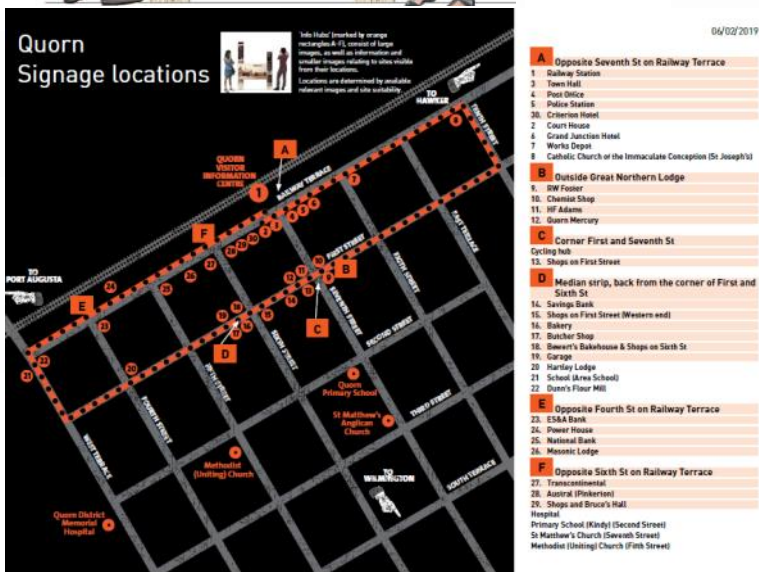

The deduction applies for cost incurred on fire activities on your primary production land. You can claim, quick fill pumps, high rise drive under water tanks, lightweight water tanks for utility vehicles, fire protection sprinklers systems in sheds, fire dams. - * Petrol's, oil, solvents, degreaser's and other manufacturing substances.
- * Agricultural chemicals and pesticides
- * Buried waste products.
