

Council has received numerous reports of dogs roaming the streets and property gates being left open.

There are also a number of dogs within our community which still remain unregistered, please note that any dog over the age of 3 months <u>MUST</u> be registered and all dogs staying within our Council for longer than 14 days must also be registered within our Council.

Before 1 July 2018 all dogs need to be microchipped and all dogs born after the 1 July 2018 need to be Microchipped and Desexed (exemptions apply for certain classes of dogs).

#### **DEVELOPMENT**

Please be aware that all structures that are  $3m \times 3m$  (9m2) that have a solid roof are required to gain development approval prior to being installed. This includes

- Pools which can be filled to a depth greater than 300mm including inflatable pools unless they do not incorporate a filtration system.
- Spas if they hold more than 680 litres of water.
- Replacement of existing structures.
- Shipping containers, unless being used for temporary storage for less than 3 months.
