DOG AND CAT REGISTRATIONS 2018/2019

AS OF 1 JULY 2018 ALL DOGS MUST BE MICROCHIPPED.

The Expiration for any dog not microchipped is \$170, for every 3 months that it remains not microchipped.

- All dogs born after the 1 July of 2018 need to be microchipped and desexed
- To be exempt from de sexing the dog must be registered with a relevant association, or have a letter from a practicing veterinarian



Hello once again to all our residents,

Most of you will now know that there has been a positive resolution to the circumstances surrounding the loss of the Pichi Richi Marathon. I strongly acknowledge the role of the CEO, and commitment of all Councillors, in providing the necessary backing and support for us to meet with Rotary and determine suitable solutions to the road safety issues which were driving the changes which had been announced. Whilst this has been a difficult episode, there has been a strong surge in community interest around the event and I encourage all community members with an interest in supporting the long term future of the Pichi Richi Marathon to become more involved for the benefit of our community, our region and the Marathon.
