MEDIA RELEASE CORONA VIRUS UPDATE

23rd November 2020

In accordance with the new Emergency Management (Public Activities No. 12) directive issued by the State Coordinator (Under the Emergency Management Act 2004) for South Australia, it has been assessed and determined that the following non-essential Council facilities will be **reopened** to the public:

- Hawker Swimming Pool (Lap Swimming only);
- Quorn Swimming Pool (Lap Swimming Only);
- The Visitor Information Centre (Quorn) (**EFTPOS Only - No Cash Facilities at this time**);
- Quorn Community Hall;
- Quorn Town Hall;
- Hawker Institute;
- Quorn Skate Park;
- Quorn Courthouse Museum;
- All Parks, Gardens, Ovals, Reserves, Playgrounds, Walking Trails and Open Areas;
- All Public Toilets;
- Quorn Silo Art Projection;
- Waste Transfer Station Quorn (**EFTPOS Only - No Cash Facilities at this time**);
- Landfill Hawker (**EFTPOS Only - No Cash Facilities at this time**);
- Council Depot Quorn;
- Council Depot Hawker;
- Quorn Oval Camping;

Community and other organisations that lease or otherwise occupy Council owned facilities will be notified by Council whether they can reopen or whether they must remain closed.

The following facilities will continue to remain 'open' at this time:

- Council Office Quorn; (**Social distancing restrictions apply**)

Please be aware that additional COVID safety measures may be in place at these sites.

The normal weekly refuse collection and fortnightly recycling collections will continue as normal.

Council will continue to assess the risk for staff and the community over the coming days and will keep the community informed of any changes.
